ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE: All pre-entries for agility trial must be **RECEIVED** by **April 24, 2020**. To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made **payable to Liz Clements**. You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form). **NO DOG MAY RUN** (Except FEO's) without a registration form completed prior to their first run (registration form attached).
Move ups accepted until day of trial via email; day of trial move-ups also accepted.

Judging schedule will be sent out before day of show and posted on jumpingcrew.com

Near & Far Game, Std 4, Tunnel Jacks Game, Std 5 & 6 (Beta), Puppy Cannon Game

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height in each class and to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. We offer Title ribbons, Championship ribbons and bars!! **Please let us know in advance if you will possibly be getting your TACH at this event.**

MEASURING & CHECK-IN: All dogs without a jump height card will need to be measured before the first class. **A photocopy of your signed temporary jump height measurement form will be accepted in Lieu of the permanent jump height card.**

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Class

Beginner Agility- All dogs shall be eligible for participation in the class. There shall be no grand fathering of titles from other organizations

Intermediate Agility – Dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dogs that have earned a title from another organization may “Fast Track” in this class.

Superior Agility – Dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class as are dogs that have Fast Tracked through the Beginner and Intermediate levels. (dogs who have earned the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) are also eligible for this class.

Games Classes

(Judge’s instructions govern. These are just the general rules)

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand fathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II – Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III - Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Dare to Double is a dog’s-choice game. The objective is to score as many points as possible, repeating a doubling obstacle on course (traditionally the A-frame) as often as time allows. The dog risks losing half his points if the A-frame is faulted! The dog must get to the finish.

Tunnel Snooker is a two-part game. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. The first is dog’s-choice in which the dog earns the right to score three "colored" obstacles by doing a red tunnel before each. The second part is a simple sequence.

Rodeo is a three-part game consisting of events held in a rodeo: Barrel racing using tunnels, pole bending using the weaves, and bronco riding which is a short Jumpers course.

Near and Far is a simple sequencing game with two modest distance challenges. For the most part the handler can run along with his dog (Near); but in the distance challenges the dog must work away (Far).

Tunnel Jacks is adapted from the children’s game of jacks. Doing a pipe tunnel represents the bounce of the ball, and on each turn the dog must be directed to pick up more points: onsies first, then twosies... and so forth.

Puppy Cannon is a game featuring the pipe tunnel as a test of the handler’s skill when redirecting the dog. It is typically played with three (or more) small numbered sequences that can be taken in the order of the handler’s choosing.

Judges briefing on day of trial supersedes any previous briefings

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to ALL dogs that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect a dog's physical or mental performance. **NO DOG MAY RUN** without a registration form completed prior to their first run (registration form attached).

FEO (For Exhibition Only) – Will run last at their chosen jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 times of the SCT.

The following is a list of obstacles that will be used at this trial:

Dogwalk (12'x12' planks, 4' high)

Teeter 12'x12" rubber granules,

Table (standard 3'x3' – 6" & 12" high)

Weave Poles (24" spacing)

Tunnels (24" diameter)

Tire Jump (24" diameter)

Jumps (4')

A-Frame (9'x 3' slated, apex 44")

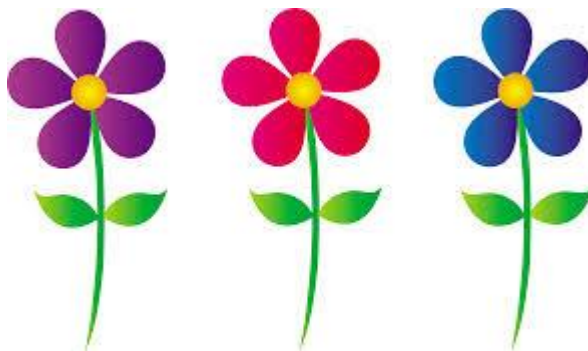
A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Other obstacles may or may not be included in the warm-up areas. We do offer obstacle familiarization at this trial at the start of each day.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division.

- ❖ 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less
- ❖ 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less
- ❖ 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 17" or less
- ❖ 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers and dogs over 20" will be scored with the 16" except for tournaments where there will be a special category for them.

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long back, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see rules at www.k9tdaa.com for a complete description of height exemptions). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required to be received before the first day of the trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25 for returned checks. In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- A warm up area consisting of at least an agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization on the equipment will be offered 30 minutes before the first class each day.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations of the TDAA.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show. If your entry is illegible the secretary will attempt to contact you. If unable to contact you the entry will be returned to you.
- Disabled handlers will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in SCT in the Standard class and in the qualifying course time for game classes.
- Please bring shade for yourself and your dog(s). There is limited shade in the crating area and it is on dirt so mats are advised.
- There are no restaurants or fast food chains near this facility so please remember to bring your breakfast/lunch. We will have water available for exhibitors and some light snacks.
- This trial will not run in the rain. If we cannot run this trial before it starts due to weather we will cancel the trial as soon as we possibly can. If we have to finish short and cannot restart the trial there will be no refunds for unfinished runs. If for some reason the trial has to be cancelled after the closing date we will do our best to reimburse as much as we can after expenses have been gone over. There is NO guarantee of a full refund. For the safety of the dogs and the humans; this trial will not run in rainy weather. Thank you!
